SATS & MTC

As we approach the summer terms, parents and carers in Years 4 and 6 will know that this will be the time when both year groups will undertake compulsory statutory assessments as planned by the Department for Education.

Year 4 will be undertaking the Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). This is statutory for all Year 4 pupils registered at state-funded schools. Miss Peeling has already prepared a letter for all Year 4 parents and carers with further details about this. In 2024, schools must administer the MTC to all eligible Year 4 pupils between Monday 3 June and Friday 14 June.

Year 6 will be undertaking the end of Key Stage 2 SATs. The 2024 Key Stage 2 SATs will take place in the week commencing 13th May 2024. The tests will take place over four days.

Monday 13 May 2024	English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2
Tuesday 14 May 2024	English reading
Wednesday 15 May 2024	Mathematics papers 1 and 2
Thursday 16 May 2024	Mathematics paper 3

It is important that during these dates that <u>all children attend school</u>. No holidays should be booked and if your child is unwell on any of these days, it is <u>vital</u> you speak to us straight away.

We wish both year groups all the best and remind them that these assessments are only a small snapshot of them in a particular situation on a particular day. They do not represent how amazing they are as a person!
